Preventive Care for Women:

Preventive Services for <u>pregnant</u> women or women <u>who may become pregnant</u>

All marketplace health plans must cover this list of preventive services without charging a copayment or coinsurance.

- 1. Anemia Screening
- 2. Breastfeeding comprehensive support and counseling
- 3. Contraception
- 4. Folic Acid
- 5. Gestational diabetes screening
- 6. Gonorrhea screening
- 7. Hepatitis B screening
- 8. Rh Incompatibility screening
- 9. Syphilis screening
- 10. Expanded tobacco intervention and counseling
- 11. Urinary Tract or other infection screening

Other covered preventive services for women

All marketplace health plans must cover this list of preventive services without charging a copayment or coinsurance.

- 1. Breast Cancer genetic test counseling (BRCA)
- 2. Breast cancer mammography screenings
- 3. Breast cancer chemoprevention counseling 11. Rh incompatibility screening
- 4. Cervical cancer screening
- 5. Chlamydia infection screening
- 6. Domestic and interpersonal violence screening and counseling
- 7. Gonorrhea screening

- 8. HIV screening and counseling
- 9. Human Papillomavirus (HPV) DNA test
- 10. Osteoporosis screening
- 12. Sexually transmitted infections counseling
- 13. Syphilis screening
- 14. Tobacco use screening and interventions
- 15. Well-woman visits

These services are free only when delivered by a doctor or other provider in your plan's network.



Broker Portal Quick Tip

When entering an application through the Broker portal and the Group's plan ID is not displaying, we have added a refresh button, so the system will display the plan after clicking the refresh button.

How it works:

- 1. Specify the effective date with valid effective date.
- 2. Make sure the group number is not empty.
- 3. Click the refresh button on the Plan ID field to get all available plans.
