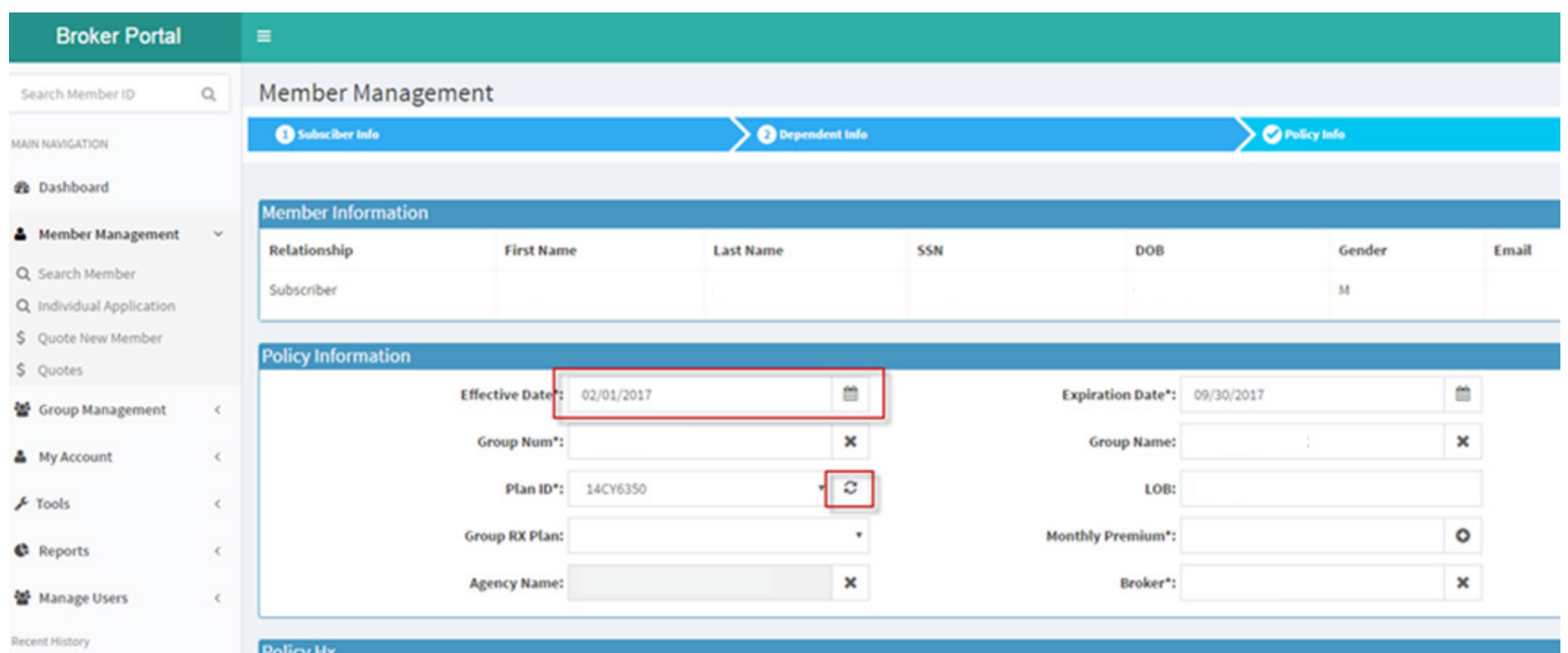

Broker Portal Quick Tip

When entering an application through the Broker portal and the Group's plan ID is not displaying, we have added a refresh button, so the system will display the plan after clicking the refresh button.

How it works:

1. Specify the effective date with valid effective date.
2. Make sure the group number is not empty.
3. Click the refresh button on the Plan ID field to get all available plans.
