COVID-19 UPDATE SPECIFICATIONS

In order to ease the burden presented by factors surrounding the public health emergency related to COVID-19, Alliant Health Plans continues to modify processes. Please note the following details of modified processes that follow. All changes are currently in effect until the end of the CMS state of emergency. All members and providers will be given a 60 day notice of any changes in benefits related to COVID-19.

The following codes are covered when billed with a Place of Service (POS) 02, or with modifier GT or 95. These codes do not require Prior Authorization (PA). *Current as of 12/10/2020.*
